There are two copies of this study contract.

A username and a password for the DPU-PUSH intranet will be sent to the student at the start of his/her studies. The student undertakes to use this platform. On the DPU-PUSH intranet platform, he/she can access important notifications, course content, scripts and information on the organization of studies, such as study and examination regulations. Any disadvantages arising from a lack of regular use shall be borne by the student. The student undertakes to use all information and documents made available to him/her via this platform for his/her own use only and not to pass them on to third parties under any circumstances.

The University is entitled to collect and process personal data in accordance with the Austrian Private Universities Act, as amended, in order to lawfully fulfill its responsibilities.

### 1. Admission to studies

- (1) Prerequisites for admission to the postgraduate university course are an internationally recognized academic degree in dentistry and the entitlement to practise the dental profession as well as at least two years of professional experience.
- (2) The course is organized over 6 semesters. The student must provide credible evidence that he/she has access to the practice/clinic (= treatment option) in order to be able to carry out the user training of the acquired knowledge and presented methods in practice in a sufficient manner, including for case presentation.



## 2. Duration of the contract

- (1) The study contract is concluded for the standard period of study of three years in accordance with the applicable examination and study regulations. The student and the DPU assume that, provided the student's studies are conducted in the proper manner, the degree program can be successfully completed within the standard period of study.
- (2) During a period of leave approved by the DPU, the term of the contract shall be suspended and tuition fees shall not be payable during this period.
- (3) Leave of absence must be requested in writing from the DPU. Important reasons include
  - Illness that makes it impossible to study properly and lasts for more than half of the lecture period of the academic year; a medical certificate must be submitted.
  - Pregnancy, maternity leave, and childcare within the scope of the statutory entitlement to parental leave as it would exist in an employment relationship.
  - Completion of military or civilian service (submission of the notice of compulsory service).
- (4) If no leave of absence is granted, the degree program must be completed within the standard period of study plus three years. If it has not been completed by then, this contract shall be deemed terminated. The tuition fee paid remains with the DPU; re-entry into the program is not possible.

## 3. Allocation of a study place

Upon conclusion of this study contract and after receipt of the agreed deposit or full payment of the tuition fees, you will be allocated a study place and enrolled as a student at DPU with the associated rights and obligations.

These arise from:

- from the General Terms and Conditions of Danube Private University GmbH (DPU) and the PUSH Postgraduale Universitätsstudien für Heilberufe GmbH,
- the study and examination regulations of the selected university course for the Master of Science (Continuing Education) (MSc) (CE) (see p. 1) and
- the data protection declaration of consent and confidentiality
- and the Code of Conduct.

in the currently valid version, which will be handed over to the student together with a copy of this contract. The obligation to pay the tuition fee arises as soon as the student submits the signed study contract to the DPU.

## 4. Amendments to these regulations

Amendments to these regulations will be published by the university and thereby become part of the contract.

## 5. Obligation to pay the tuition fees

By returning the signed study contract, the student undertakes to pay the tuition fees. These amount to a total of «**Rechnungssumme**» for six semesters

## 6. Early termination of contract

Notwithstanding Section 2, the study contract may be terminated as part of a de-registration procedure at the request of the student or by the DPU.

- (1) In all cases of extraordinary termination, tuition fees shall be payable until the end of the program, provided that the extraordinary termination is based on circumstances for which the DPU is not responsible. Extraordinary terminations by students for which there is no valid reason are permissible with four weeks' notice. The date of termination shall be the last day of the notice period.
- (2) In the event of termination before the start of the program, this shall apply mutatis mutandis, unless Section 7 applies.
- (3) The DPU's obligation to provide proper training shall lapse and justify immediate termination of this study contract by the DPU without notice if the student's further participation in the training is impossible or unreasonable. This shall be assumed, among other things, in the event of a significant violation of the regulations specified in Section 8, in particular the requirements of the examination regulations, as well as in the event of late payment of tuition fees.

## 7. Revocation

The student has the right to revoke this contract without cause within fourteen days of entering into this contract. The period to revoke the document is fourteen days from the date of the signing of the contract..

In order to exercise the right of revocation, the student must inform Danube Private University GmbH (DPU), Steiner Landstraße 124, 3500 Krems an der Donau, Austria, of his/her decision to revoke this contract by means of a clear statement (e.g. a letter sent via post or e-mail to [msc@dp-uni.ac.at](mailto:msc@dp-uni.ac.at)).

The student may use the attached sample revocation form, but this is not mandatory. To meet the revocation deadline, it is sufficient for the student to send notification of exercising the right of revocation before the revocation period has expired.

### Consequences of Revocation

If the contract is revoked, DPU must refund all payments of tuition fees that it has received from the student immediately and at the latest within fourteen days from the day on which the DPU receives notification of the revocation of the contract. The same means of payment used for the original transaction will be used for this repayment. Under no circumstances will the student be charged any fees for this repayment.

## 8. Miscellaneous

- (1) By signing this agreement, the student undertakes to pay the tuition fees including the ÖH student fees for the duration of his/her studies.
- (2) The place of fulfillment for the mutual services is Krems. Nevertheless, courses of up to 40 % can take place online. It will be communicated before the beginning of each semester which courses will take place online and which will take place in person in Krems..
- (3) Amendments and supplements to this study contract as well as ancillary agreements must be made in writing. Annexes to this contract are integral parts of the contract.
- (4) Should one or more provisions of this contract be or become invalid, for whatever reason, this shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions. The contracting parties are obliged to replace invalid provisions as soon as possible with new valid provisions that come as close as possible to the original purpose of the contract.
- (5) This contract and all disputes arising in connection with this contract shall be governed by Austrian law to the exclusion of the conflict of law rules.
- (6) The place of jurisdiction for all disputes arising in connection with this contract shall be the court with local jurisdiction for Krems an der Donau.
